Correct Method of Ball Mark Repair

RIGHT

- 1) Insert tool on the high side behind the ballmark.
- Push the back of the ball mark toward the center.
 Do not lift or twist with the tool.
- 4) Close the hole by pushing both sides of the mark into the center.
- Gently tap the surface down with your putter.
- Never use a piece of loosened turf for repair.



Only YOU can prevent ball mark damage! Remember:





Insert tool and push back and sides forward to center -no damage to root system. Healing starts immediately.

Rules

My Ball Hit Another Ball

Rule 11.1 states if a player's ball in motion hits another ball, there is no penalty to any player and, with the exception of the putting green, is normally played where it lies. There is one exception to this rule. This exception applies only to **stroke play**.

If the player's ball in motion hits another ball at rest on the putting green and both balls were on the putting green before the stroke, the player gets the general penalty which is two strokes.

Keep in mind that you have the right to ask to have any ball marked and lifted if you think it may interfere with play. Don't be afraid to ask, it may save you two strokes.
