President's Message

Spring is taking its time, but soon everything will be in full bloom and with the heat comes the growth of grass roots. That is what we need to get our MountainView front nine open for play. We are hoping for April 15, but no guarantees. It is entirely up to the warmth of the sun.

A couple of reminders, or explanations, for your play on the MountainView course, concerning hole Number 11. The ditch on 11 is an Environmentally Sensitive Area and we are not to drive through it nor hit golf balls out of it. You must take your ball out of it and drop it no closer to the flag at a cost of 1 stroke. The ditch has been hydro seeded so is a flora area. In the future you will be able to try to hit out of it if you want to try, but not now. The other surfaces that are dirt and have been hydro seeded are also areas that you shouldn't drive through nor hit out of. You should walk to your ball, bring it to the closest spot on the grass no closer to the flag, take a drop and hit. There is no penalty for this action.

Those playing The Preserve Course have noticed a temporary change on Holes 1 and 10 tee boxes. Due to the large number of players playing on the green tees, they are showing wear. Paul and his crew are trying to provide necessary care.

It appears that golfers are being much better at caring for our courses: sanding yours and other golfers' divots, driving 90 degrees on the fairways, repairing marks on the greens, and raking bunkers. You should plan to refill your sand bottles at least once or twice per round until we can get ahead of the divots.

We are looking for more volunteers for the Adopt-a-Hole program. Diane Marchand is running the program and reports that she could use a few additional volunteers on MountainView and several more at The Preserve. If you would be willing to step up and help, please call Diane at 562-972-3697. Your contribution will be much appreciated, and for those already helping – A Big Thank You!

Correct Method of Ball Mark Repair

- 1) Insert tool on the high side behind the ballmark.
- 2) Push the back of the ball mark toward the center.
- 3) Do not lift or twist with the tool.
- 4) Close the hole by pushing both sides of the mark into the center.
- 5) Gently tap the surface down with your putter.
- 6) Never use a piece of loosened turf for repair.



Only YOU can prevent ball mark damage!




WRONG!
